


Let's Celebrate!

In **class 1**, we have been learning about homes in the past. The reception children built a Victorian home with a sofa and a fire.

In class 2 this week we have been learning about 2D and 3D shapes.





This week, class 3 have begun to look at arrays as the start to our multiplication topic. We began by completing some arrays using Minecraft blocks and as the week has gone on, we have looked at matching calculations to groups of arrays

In **class 4** we have been exploring how to make complete circuits. We realised if there is a break or gap in the circuit that it will not work.





This week, in **class 5** in advance of our class trip to Tropical World, we studied the way in which animals have adapted to suit their environments. Linking to our English topic work, we learned about the special adaptations wolves have to help them survive, then explored the adaptations of an animal of our own choice.
